There are some rules in place to help promote the "Bluegrass Genre" of music. Some examples are:

- (1) Persons are required to have timing, without it everyone is "OFF"
- (2) Know what song or tune they are going to do when their turn comes around.
- (3) Have their song memorized (No song books in front of them.)
- (4) No more than two of the same instrument playing at a time in any song. For example if there are five guitars each will be given a number which will determine when you play. If there are two or more bass players, each may play but one must be more dominant (or louder) for the group to follow. They may switch the dominant position using the number system like the fore mentioned guitars.

I am working on getting musicians to teach their instrument to others interested in learning this STYLE of music. These would be beginner classes in the "Bluegrass style."
